Direction for Use

Relocating the Product

- Do not drag the mattress on the floor when moving it. It must be lifted and carried.

Care Instructions

- Turn over or rotate the mattress every two months to prevent it from absorbing moisture and sinking.
 - Cover the mattress with a fitted sheet, etc. when using the product.
 - When washing the covers (outer shells), follow the washing instructions on the covers and handle them properly.
 - For instructions on how to install and remove the covers (outer shells), see the Removal/Installation Instructions.
- Disposal**
 - To dispose of the product, follow the rules implemented by your local government.

Warning Hazards that may lead to death or serious injury

DONTs

- Do not lay small children on the product. Doing so may cause them to suffocate or fall on the floor.
- Do not apply an excessive load to one side of the product. Doing so may cause damage to the mattress, resulting in injury.
- Do not stand or jump on the bed. Doing so may result in injury or damage to the product.
- Do not smoke on the bed. Doing so may cause a fire.
- Do not place near a heat source such as a heater. Doing so may cause a fire.
- Make sure that the bedding does not come in contact with the lighting fixture when it is turned on. Otherwise the heat generated by the lighting fixture may cause a fire.
- Do not allow more than the specified number of people to use at the same time. Doing so may cause damage to the product, resulting in injury. (See the product specifications for details.)
- Do not leave unnecessary packaging materials within reach of small children. Small children may accidentally pull them over their heads and cover their mouth and/or nose, causing suffocation.

DOs

- Periodically remove the mattress from the bed. Temperature difference between the inside and the outside of the mattress and moisture trapped inside may cause mould growth, resulting in health hazards.

DONTs

- Do not use for other than its intended purpose. Doing so may cause unexpected accident or injury.

DOs

- Regularly ventilate the room. Especially under the following conditions, infestation of mould and mites may occur, leading to health hazards.
 - Humid season
 - When condensation occurs due to difference between indoor and outdoor temperatures (e.g. in winter)
 - Excessive use of a humidifier
- Make sure to place a bed pad on the mattress to avoid moisture damage or stains from sweat, etc.

Notes (Other Cautions)

- Load capacity of washing machine (approx.): Bed cover...8 kg or more
 - To prevent accidents and damage to the washing machine, follow the washing machine instructions regarding capacity and washing methods. Consult a dry cleaning service if the covers cannot be washed in your washing machine.
- Use a laundry net. Otherwise the covers may pop out of the washing machine tub.
- Wash the upper and lower covers at the same time.
- Close the fastener before washing.
- Do not tumble dry.
- The non-woven fabric cover pre-attached to the mattress cannot be washed.
- The urethane foam of the mattress will turn yellow over time.

Removal/Installation Instructions

1

Open the fastener by sliding the pull and remove Ⓑ upper cover (outer shell).

2

Take out Ⓐ mattress.

Caution

Make sure to remove and install the covers with two or more people.

Caution

Do not open the fastener of the non-woven fabric cover pre-attached to the mattress.

Place Ⓒ lower cover (outer shell) over Ⓐ mattress and pull down the hem while aligning the corners of the cover and the mattress.

2

Turn over Ⓐ mattress.

3

Place Ⓑ upper cover (outer shell) over the mattress. Then insert the insertion pin of the fastener on Ⓑ upper cover (outer shell) into the slider of the fastener on Ⓒ lower cover (outer shell).

4

Slowly close the fastener while firmly holding Ⓑ upper cover (outer shell) down from the top. Finally, smooth out Ⓑ Ⓒ covers (outer shells).
* The mattress is double-sided. Both upper and lower covers can be used on either side of the mattress.

Caution

- Do not force the fastener open or close. The covers are designed tight to ensure a perfect fit. Be careful not to damage the product when installing the covers especially after washed.
- Be careful not to get injured by the slider of the fastener.
- Be careful not to scratch the headboard of your bed or the wall with the slider of the fastener.
