


Cautions

Before Use

- O Do not use the product if small scratches or cracks are found on the product. Otherwise it may cause damage.
- Wash each part thoroughly with lukewarm water and assemble the parts correctly before use.
- O not sterilize in boiling water. The heat may cause deformation, cracking, cloudiness and/or discolouration.
- O Do not use in the following drinks.
- Dry ice, soda and fermented food: The internal pressure may rise causing the product to explode.
- Milk, milk-based beverages, fruit juice and fruit pulp, etc.: May spoil or deteriorate.
- Tea leaves, coffee powder, tea bags with strings, etc.: May get caught in the inner cap causing leakage.

During Use

Do not put beverage at a temperature of 50 °C or higher into the product. When putting tea or other boiled drinks, wait until the temperature drops. Otherwise this may cause burns. It may also cause product deformation, damage or leakage.

Recommended temperature of beverage is 50 °C or lower.


- When carrying, do not shake it, turn it sideways, or upside down. It may cause leakage.
- O Do not use as storage containers. It may cause spoilage and/or deterioration.
- O Do not use in a freezer, chiller compartment or other places where the temperature drops below freezing. The liquid may freeze and expand, causing damage to the body.
- O Do not use in a microwave.
- On not use while driving. It may stain the inside of the car or clothes. Also, use while driving may result in lack of caution and may cause serious danger.
- O Do not place near open flames. It may cause damage or a fire.
- On not apply strong impact or excessive force, such as dropping or tipping over. Doing so may cause damage.
- O Do not remove the lid with the cover raised. The cover hinge may become damaged.
- O Do not place in an unstable place. The body may fall over.
- O Do not swing or lift vigorously by the strap. The strap may become damaged.

After Use

- Wash with neutral dish detergent, rinse well and dry after use before storing.
- Do not wash with an abrasive scouring pad, wire wool, or cleanser. Doing so may scratch the surface and cause product breakage.
- O Do not put in a dishwasher.
- Do not sterilize in boiling water. The heat may cause deformation, cracking, cloudiness and/or discolouration.

Directions for Use

- Wash each part thoroughly with lukewarm water and assemble the parts correctly before use.
- To drink, hold the bottle upright and press the button to unlock. Press the lock to open the cover and slowly tilt the bottle.
- When you have finished drinking, close the cover in an upright position and lock the button until you hear a click.
- * The open and closed states are as shown in the figure. Make sure to lock it when not drinking to prevent the cover from opening unexpectedly.
- When removing the strap, position it perpendicular to the bottle and lower it slowly. (Position of dotted line in the right figure)





- To prevent damage to the strap, do not apply strong force when removing or attaching it.
- When washing, remove the inner cap, use a soft sponge with a neutral dish detergent and rinse thoroughly.
- Water droplets may form on the inside of the cover. Be careful not to let water drops fall on your clothes when opening and closing.
- After washing, wipe dry with a soft cloth.
