

Care Instructions

- Rotate the mattress once every two months to prevent it from sagging and moisture from being trapped, or switch the positions of (A) coil units inside the covers.
- Place a separately sold fitted sheet or any other covering on the product.
- When washing (C) top cover and (D) bottom cover, follow the wash care instructions on the label of the covers and handle them properly.
- For instructions on how to install and remove (C) top cover and (D) bottom cover, see Directions for Use.

Directions for Use

Moving the Product

- When moving the product, do not drag it on the floor. It must be lifted and carried by at least two adults holding the underside of the product with both hands.


Disposal

- To dispose of the product, follow the rules implemented by your local government.






Removing the Covers

- 1 Hold the pull tab and open the fastener. Then remove (C) top cover.



Note (Other Caution) Make sure to remove and install the covers with two or more people.

- 2 Take out (B) cushioning material and (A) coil units.



Note (Other Caution) Do not open the fasteners on the non-woven fabric covers of (A) coil units and (B) cushioning material.


Installing the Covers

- 1 ① Check the "BOTTOM SIDE" labels on (A) coil units and (B) cushioning material.




CAUTION Top side and bottom side of (A) coil units and (B) cushioning material are different. The side with this label is bottom side. ① Make sure to place (A) coil units and (B) cushioning material with their bottom sides facing down. Placing them in an incorrect orientation can cause product damage or injury.


- 2 Spread (D) bottom cover and place (A) coil units in it first on both sides and next in the middle with the "BOTTOM SIDE" label shown above facing down.



- 3 Place (B) cushioning material on the three pieces of (A) coil units placed in the previous step.




- 2 Place (C) top cover over it and insert the insertion pin of the fastener on (C) top cover into the slider of the fastener on (D) bottom cover.



- 3 Slowly close the fastener while securely holding (C) top cover from above.

Finally, adjust (C) top cover and (D) bottom cover to make sure they fit in place.

⊘ DON'Ts

- Do not lay small children on the product. Doing so may cause them to suffocate or fall on the floor.
- Do not put excessive load only on one side. Doing so may damage the parts and lead to injury.
- Do not stand or jump on the product. Doing so may cause tip-over, damage and/or injury.
- Do not allow more than the specified number of people to use at the same time. Doing so may cause damage, resulting in injury. (See the Specifications for details.)
- Do not leave unnecessary packaging materials within reach of small children. Children may accidentally pull them over their head, cover their mouth and/or nose and suffocate.

! DOs

- Make sure that the bedding does not come in contact with lighting fixtures when they are turned on. Otherwise the heat may cause a fire.
- Regularly remove the mattress from the bed. Temperature difference between the inside and outside of the mattress and moisture trapped inside may cause mould growth, leading to health hazards.

⚠ CAUTION Hazards that may result in injury or damage to the property

! DOs

- Regularly ventilate the room. Especially under the following conditions, infestation of mould and mites may occur, leading to health hazards.
 - Humid season
 - When condensation occurs due to difference between indoor and outdoor temperatures (e.g. in winter)
 - Excessive use of a humidifier
- Make sure to place a bed pad on the mattress to avoid moisture damage or stains from sweat, etc.

Note (Other Caution)

Washing Instructions of (C) Top Cover, (D) Bottom Cover

- Load capacity of washing machine (approx.): Bed cover...8 kg or more
 - * To prevent accidents and damage to the washing machine, follow the washing machine instructions regarding capacity and washing methods. Consult a dry cleaning service if the covers cannot be washed in your washing machine.
- Be sure to put in a laundry net when washing. Otherwise the covers may pop out of the washing machine tub.
- Do not tumble dry.

Other

- The non-woven fabric covers of (A) coil units and (B) cushioning material are not washable.
- (B) cushioning material will turn yellow due to the characteristic of the material.

⚠ CAUTION

- ⊘ Do not wash (A) coil units and (B) cushioning material. They are not designed to be washed, and the materials are not washable.
- ⊘ Do not forcibly open/close the fastener of (C) top cover and (D) bottom cover. The covers are designed to fit tightly to ensure a snug fit. If you feel they are tight when installing them (especially after washing), carefully open/close the faster to prevent damage.
- ! Be careful not to get injured by the pull tab and slider of the fastener on (C) top cover and (D) bottom cover.
- ! Be careful not to scratch the headboard or wall by the pull tab and slider of the fastener on (C) top cover and (D) bottom cover.
