DON'Ts

- Do not leave unnecessary packaging materials within reach of small children. Children may accidentally pull them over their head, cover their mouth and/or nose and suffocate.
- Do not lay small children on the product. Doing so may cause them to suffocate or fall on the floor.
- Do not let children use without supervision. Doing so may result in unexpected injury.
- Do not climb or stand on the product. Otherwise it may cause you to fall, the product to become unstable and fall over or become damaged, leading to injury.
- Do not use in an unstable position, such as tilting while sitting on the product. Otherwise this may cause tip-over, damage, injury and/or floor scratches.
- Do not sit near the edge of the seat. Doing so may cause tip-over, damage and/or injury.
- Do not sit on any part other than the seat. Doing so may result in unexpected injury.
- Do not use if damaged or deformed. Doing so may cause injury due to insufficient strength of the product.
- Do not use for other than its intended purpose. Doing so may cause damage, resulting in injury.
- Do not place on the power cord of an electrical appliance. Doing so may damage the cord, leading to electric shock or a fire.
- Do not attempt to repair or modify. Doing so reduces the strength of the product and may lead to injury.

DON'Ts

- Do not install in locations with high temperatures and humidity for a long time. Doing so may cause mould and mites to grow, leading to health hazards.
- Do not place anything near or above the product. It may fall and cause injury in the event of an earthquake, etc.

CAUTION (Continued)

Hazards that may result in injury or damage to the property

DON'Ts

- Install slightly (about 10 cm) away from the wall. This is to prevent air stagnation and condensation on the wall, and eventually mould growth. Avoiding direct contact with the wall also prevents discolouration of the wall paper.
- The product must be moved by at least two adults. Moving it alone may result in product damage and/or injury.
- Avoid exposure to direct sunlight and heat or air from heating and cooling appliances such as an air conditioner and a heater. Otherwise it may cause warping, distortion, cracking, or discolouration.
- Ventilate the room well at the early stage of use. Formaldehyde contained in adhesive may still remain, and those with chemical sensitivity and small children may experience allergic reactions.
- Apply ④ felt pads to the bottom of the legs, or use an underlay. This is to protect the floor from scratches and discolouration due to reaction between the coating on the wooden parts and the floor when the product is installed on a cushioned vinyl flooring.

Note (Other Caution)

- Do not place in locations with high temperatures or low humidity for a long time. Doing so may cause warping, distortion or cracking.
- Avoid use in locations exposed to direct sunlight. If exposure to direct sunlight is unavoidable, use curtains, etc. to reduce the amount of sunlight.
- Do not use bleach or organic solvents, such as thinner, for cleaning. Doing so may cause discolouration or deformation.
- Wipe off immediately when disinfectant containing alcohol is spilled on the coating or covering material. Do not excessively wipe with alcohol disinfectant. Doing so may cause discolouration or deterioration of the surface.
- Do not leave a chemically treated cloth in contact with the product for a long time. Doing so may cause discolouration or peeling of the surface material.
- Install on a flat and stable surface. Using on an unstable surface may cause distortion or damage of the product.

General Notes

Formaldehyde Countermeasures

- What is Formaldehyde?
Formaldehyde is said to be a cause of sick house syndrome. It is a colourless, pungent-smelling chemical that vaporises at room temperature, often found in furniture, building materials, wallpaper adhesives, etc. As it is gradually released into the air, spending a long time in a room contaminated with formaldehyde can result in eye/throat irritation. Also, exposure to a high concentration of formaldehyde may cause breathing difficulties.
- Room Ventilation

Ventilate the room well when installing the furniture. Some individuals sensitive to chemicals and small children may experience allergic symptoms.

Be sure to frequently ventilate the room on a regular basis as formaldehyde is released into the air. Especially when installing multiple pieces of furniture at the same time, open the windows wide enough to allow adequate ventilation. Formaldehyde release tends to increase with temperature rise of the room. Therefore, be sure to ventilate well after the room has been closed up for a long time during summer. It is recommended that you open multiple windows and use a ventilation fan or an air circulator to increase ventilation efficiency.

- For Individuals Sensitive to Chemicals
There are individual differences in resistance to chemicals that are related to sick house syndrome other than formaldehyde. Therefore, even if the actual concentration in the room is lower than the indoor concentration guideline value (acceptable safe level of formaldehyde indoors), some people may react to formaldehyde. This furniture are made with materials that contain as little formaldehyde as possible, but note this does not guarantee that they are completely formaldehyde-free. It is recommended that you seek medical attention if you experience any allergic symptoms.
- Formaldehyde Adsorption/Decomposition Sheet
Formaldehyde is reabsorbed onto materials when there is nowhere for it to dissipate in a confined space. Therefore, a formaldehyde adsorption/ decomposition sheet is included in the packaging to reduce formaldehyde concentration as much as possible before the product reaches the customer.
* The effect of the sheet will be diminished by the time the product reaches the customer. Dispose of the sheet as burnable waste after unpackaging.

Assembly Instructions

CAUTION

ⓘ

Secure enough space and place an underlay when assembling the product. This prevents the floor and other furniture from scratches.

ⓘ

The product must be assembled by at least two adults. Assembling it alone may cause tip-over, damage, injury and/or floor scratches.

ⓘ

Apply ④ felt pads to the bottom of the legs or use an underlay. This is to protect the floor from scratches and discolouration due to reaction between the coating on the wooden parts and the floor when the product is installed on a cushioned vinyl flooring.

① Place ① body on the floor with an underlay.

② With two or more people, turn over the body so the product is laid on its back.

3

Make sure that the legs are securely fixed. Then with two persons or more, lift up the sofa to turn it back to the upright position.

2

① Put the bolts of ② legs through ③ washers and screw them into the screw holes on the bottom of the body. (4 places)

② Apply ④ felt pads to the bottom of the legs as necessary.

CAUTION

ⓘ

When bringing the sofa back to the upright position, be careful not to apply excessive load on one side of the legs. Doing so may cause damage or scratches on the floor.
