**WARNING**


Hazards that may lead to death or serious injury

**DON'TS**


- Do not allow small children to hang from or climb on the product. Doing so may cause the product to fall over, resulting in injury.
- Do not let children stand, climb on, or hang from the drawer. Otherwise this may cause the product to tip over and lead to serious accidents.
- Do not place anything exceeding the withstand load (Total Withstand Load: approx. 5 kg / 4-drawer type: approx. 2 kg / 2-tier drawers type: approx. 3 kg) or anything only on one side even if it is within the withstand load. Doing so may cause deformation or damage to the product, resulting in injury.
- Do not place a TV on top of the product. Doing so can make the product more likely to tip over or cause the TV to fall and lead to serious accidents.
- Do not attempt to repair or modify. Doing so may cause insufficient strength, leading to injury.
- Do not open multiple drawers at the same time. Doing so may cause the product to fall over, resulting in injury.
- Do not store items only in the upper drawer(s). Doing so may cause the product to lose its balance and fall over, leading to injury.
- Do not place on the power cord of an electrical appliance. Doing so may damage the cord, leading to electric shock or a fire.
- Do not keep the fitting parts within reach of small children, and do not lose them. Small parts may cause accidental swallowing and choking.
- Do not leave unnecessary packaging materials within reach of small children. Children may accidentally pull them over their head, cover their mouth and/or nose and suffocate.
- Do not use outdoors. Doing so may cause deformation or severe degradation, resulting in injury.

**DOs**


- Use a commercially available anti-tip fittings to prevent tip-over.
- If there are small children, attach commercially available corner guards. This is to prevent children from injuring themselves in case they fall against the product.
- Store the heaviest items in the bottom drawer(s). This is to increase the stability of the product and make it less likely to tip over.

**CAUTION**

Hazards that may result in injury or damage to the property

**DON'TS**

- Do not lift the products when they are stacked. Doing so may cause them to fall and lead to injury.
- Do not pull the drawers with excessive force or climb them. Doing so may cause the product to tip over or become damaged, resulting in injury.
- Do not touch the moving parts and gaps when opening/closing the drawers. Doing so may cause your hands or fingers to get caught and injured.
- Do not use for other than its intended purpose. Doing so may cause product damage and lead to injury.
- Do not store small children's clothing, etc. inside. Distinctive smell of the product material may linger on the clothing and become a health hazard.
- Do not use the product on an uneven floor when felt pads are applied to it. Doing so may cause them to come off, leading to dirt or scratches on the floor surface.
- Do not use if damaged or deformed. Doing so may cause insufficient strength of the product, resulting in injury.
- Do not stack more than two units, and do not forcefully push the upper part. Doing so may cause tip-over or damage, resulting in injury.
- Do not drag or drop when moving the product. Doing so may cause product damage and/or floor scratches.

**DOs**


- When stacking the products, be sure to fix in place using Metal Joint Fittings For Pulp Board Boxes (sold separately) on the back of the main unit.
- Open/close the drawer while slightly lifting it up when the product is installed directly on the floor. Not doing so may scratch the floor.

**Note (Other Caution)**


- Ventilate the room well at the early stage of use. Wooden materials that emit as little formaldehyde as possible are used. However, formaldehyde may still remain, and those with chemical sensitivity or small children may experience allergic reactions.
- Formaldehyde Adsorption/Decomposition Sheet  
Formaldehyde is re-adsorbed onto materials when there is nowhere for it to dissipate in a confined space. Therefore, a formaldehyde adsorption/decomposition sheet is included in the packaging to reduce formaldehyde concentration as much as possible before the product reaches the customer.  
\* The effect of the sheet will be diminished by the time the product reaches the customer. Dispose of the sheet as burnable waste after unpackaging.








**CAUTION**

- When using in a Stacking Shelf (sold separately) or in a location where the product may fall, attach ④ anti-slip pads to the product.
- When installing the product directly on a floor, apply the provided ③ felt pads to four places on the bottom.
- Install slightly away from the wall. This is to prevent air stagnation and condensation on the wall, and eventually mould growth. Avoiding direct contact with the wall also prevents discolouration of the wall paper.

**CAUTION**

⊗ Do not install stacked products in the middle of a room to use them as a partition. Doing so may cause the products to tip over, resulting in injury.

⊗ Do not forcefully push the upper part. Doing so may cause the products to become damaged or fall, resulting in injury.


⊗ Do not place heavy items only in the upper section, as doing so can cause the products to become unstable.

⊗ The product has top and bottom sides. Be sure to stack in the correct orientation, and do not stack upside down.

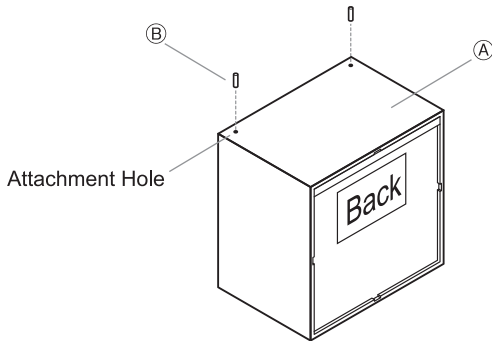

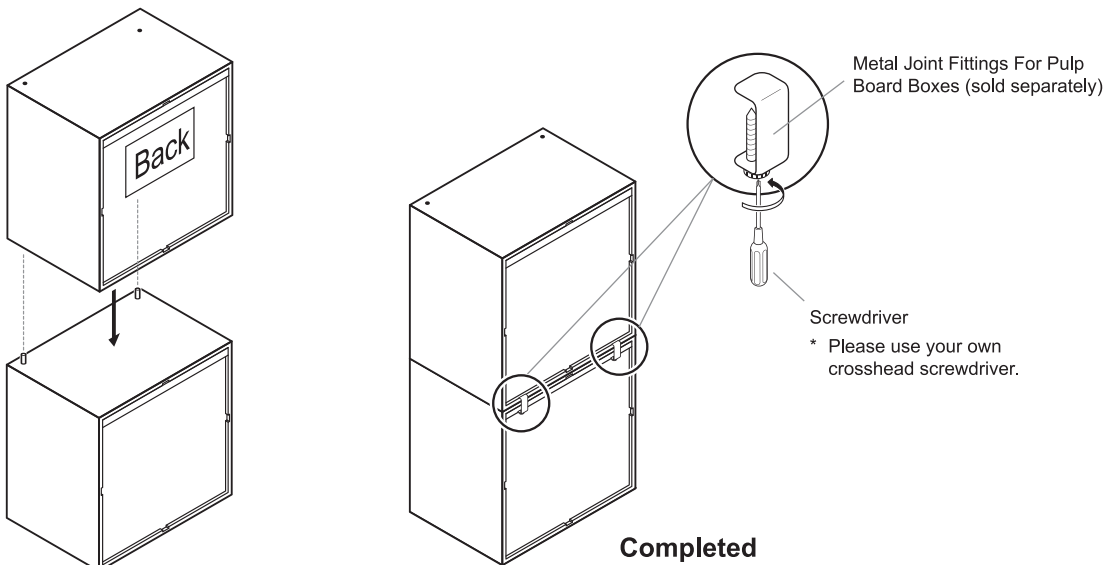
Metal Joint Fittings For Pulp Board Boxes (set of 2)



**1** Insert ② joint pins into the attachment holes on ① main unit.




**2** Place another unit on top and fix the units using Metal Joint Fittings For Pulp Board Boxes (sold separately).
