

Hiroshima Toyo Carp Pop-up Store Arrives in Singapore for the First Time

Singapore, 10 July 2025 - For the first time ever, the Hiroshima Toyo Carp, one of Japan's most beloved professional baseball teams, will launch an official pop-up store overseas, a limited-time experience in the heart of Singapore. From 19 July to 31 August 2025, visitors can experience this exclusive showcase at MUJI Plaza Singapura, Open MUJI space. OPEN MUJI, a concept rolled out by MUJI in stores worldwide, serves as a co-creation space that connects regions and cultures. This makes the event especially meaningful as a platform for cultural exchange between Japan and Singapore.

Founded in 1949, the Hiroshima Toyo Carp began as a true citizens' baseball team, one of the few professional teams in Japan without a corporate parent. In its early years, the team faced financial hardship and on-field struggles but was sustained by the unwavering support of local residents and businesses. This deep community connection has fostered a unique bond between the team and the people of Hiroshima, who continue to embrace the Carp as their own.

The team's signature red color aligns with Singapore's national color, adding symbolic resonance to its debut in Singapore. The team's mascot, a carp climbing a waterfall, is a traditional symbol of perseverance and success, reflecting the team's spirit and legacy.

Hiroshima fans are among the most passionate in Japan. At their home ground, Mazda Stadium, stands are awash in red as fans cheer in unison, creating an electric and unified atmosphere. The culture of "fighting as one", players and fans alike, is a defining trait of the Carp experience, making it one of the most spirited teams in professional baseball.
