

HOW TO HANDLETTER ON A CHRISTMAS ORNAMENT

TOOLS TO USE

- Sketching
 - MUJI Recycled Paper Sketchbook
 - o Pencil
 - o Eraser
 - o Ruler
- On Ornament
 - Ornament
 - o Stabilo All-Pencil
 - Sharpie PAINT Marker
 - o Decorative for ornaments (i.e. ribbons, snowflakes, pine branches etc.)

INSTRUCTION

1. Sketch your design on paper

- Christmas theme phrase i.e. Joy / Jolly / Merry / Noel
- Recipient's name or Family name
- Tips: Do not make the phrase too long as there is only limited surface on the ornament

2. Draft design on your ornament

- Use tissue paper to clean the surface
- Method 1: Cut out the draft and insert into the ornament
- Method 2: Use the Stabilo All-Pencil to draft directly on the ornament
- Tips: this pencil is good for drawing on many surfaces such as glasses, mirror etc. and it can be easily removed by tissue paper or cloth

3. Inking

- Oil-base marker is waterproof, and it adds a glossy touch when it is dried
- Do Faux calligraphy (which means thickening the downstrokes) as you write
- Add embellishment as needed

HOW TO PERSONALIZE GIFT PACKAGING

TOOLS TO USE

- Sketching
 - o MUJI Recycled Paper Sketchbook
 - o Pencil
 - o Eraser
 - o Ruler
- Gift Wrapping
 - o MUJI Soft Calligraphy Pen
 - o Tracing Paper/ Kraft Paper Roll/ Gift Tissue Paper

INSTRUCTION

Tips: Use non-glossy type gift wrapping paper to avoid ink smear. Kraft paper would be a good option

1. Sketch your design on paper

- Christmas theme phrases i.e. Merry Christmas / Happy Holidays
- Holiday theme song lyrics i.e. Let It Snow / Jingle Bell
- Recipient's name / Family name
- Tips: It is not necessary to have all lettering in the same style, for example you can choose a combination of block letter and script letter

2. Guideline

- Use a ruler and pencil to draw out a border in the size you need (or if you have a laser pointer, you can also use it for words alignment)
- Tips: You can also write on the entire gift-wrapping paper

3. Inking

- Use the MUJI Soft Calligraphy Pen or a marker of your choice
- When using a brush pen, you should apply more pressure with the downstrokes
- If you are using a regular marker, you can thicken the downstrokes as you go (this method is called Faux Calligraphy)
- To create a "pop-out" effect, use <u>MUJI Gel Ink Ballpoint Pen</u> and add another line to the right side of the downstrokes
- You can add ribbons and even decorate the tissue paper in the same way for additional personal touches.


